	The Original passport should be valid for at least 3 months beyond the intended duration of stay in the Schengen territory and with at least two blank page to affix the visa. The passport must have been issued within the last 10 years.			
	Copy of previous visas and stamps of the applicant's old passport(s) if any.			
	Copy of name or surname change certificate, if applicable.			
	Documents from host: □ Invitation letter signed by the spouse/cohabitant confirming current living situation, purpose of travel, itinerary, accommodation in Denmark/Iceland/Faroe Islands/Greenland and their intention to return to Thailand. □ Copy of spouse/cohabitant's passport, showing either a valid residence/work permit or O visa to Thailand.			
	Proof of relationship. Copy of marriage certificate or proof of cohabitation for at least a year.			
	Proof of occupation. Original documents confirming employment, private business, school or studies and permission for leave.			
	Documentation of funds to cover the trip. According to the Danish Immigration Service you must have the necessary means to pay for your stay and return trip. As a general rule, you must have at your disposal approx. DKK 350 per day. If you are staying in a private home and your host will cover all costs. If you are staying at a hotel, the amount must be greater, approx. DKK 500 per day. You can find further information https://www.nyidanmark.dk/			
	Overseas travel medical insurance valid for all Schengen-countries. The insurance has to cover the applicant for at least 30,000 Euros or equivalent, for all risks e.g. accident, illness, medical emergency evacuation etc. The policy has to clearly specify the period of validity and has to cover the entire duration of the trip including the date of arrival & departure.			
	If the applicant is under 18, he/she must also submit:			
	Copy of birth certificate (bring original for verification)			
	If you are travelling alone: An original letter of consent signed by both parents, stamped by Amphur. If you are travelling with only one of your parents: An original letter of consent from the other parent, stamped by Amphur.			
	If the parent you are travelling with has single custody: \Box A copy of certificate of single custody (bring <u>original</u> for verification).
